

2026 Application for \$5000 Tuition Scholarship Deadline: December 7, 2025 ifcspminorityscholarship22.blogspot.com

ELIGIBILITY: Applicant must

- Be enrolled and attending a graduate program in School Psychology that is recognized and approved by the Illinois State Board of Education
- Be member of racial or ethnic minority
- Be current member of the Illinois School Psychologists Association (ISPA)
- This is a tuition scholarship. Students who have full tuition waivers need not apply.

APPLICATION:

- Submit a résumé via email with accompanying letter that includes a 1 or 2-page autobiographical statement. Describe career goals and interests, motivation for choosing school psychology as a career, significant persons, experiences and ideas influencing personal development, and community and extracurricular activities.
- 2. Include a two-page **essay** discussing a personal perspective on social justice, citing two examples of how it impacts school climate.
- Request the release of official electronic transcripts of all graduate and undergraduate coursework completed through the end of the 2025 fall semester. Electronic transcripts due by December 7, 2025 at the address below. Email current official transcripts by January 5, 2026.
- 4. Request two letters of recommendation from university faculty. Letters address the applicant's academic competence, interpersonal skills, written/oral communication skills, character and commitment, suitability for a career in school psychology and leadership potential. Submit letters via email and a copy bearing original signature via U.S. mail.
- 5. **Interview**: Applicants who have submitted **all** required documents will be contacted by members of the Board of Directors to schedule interviews virtually or by telephone.

All applicants will be notified of the results by **January 16**, **2026**. Certificates will be presented to Award Recipients at the **Annual ISPA Awards Ceremony**. A check in the amount of \$5000 to be applied for tuition and fees will be sent to the university where the student is enrolled.
